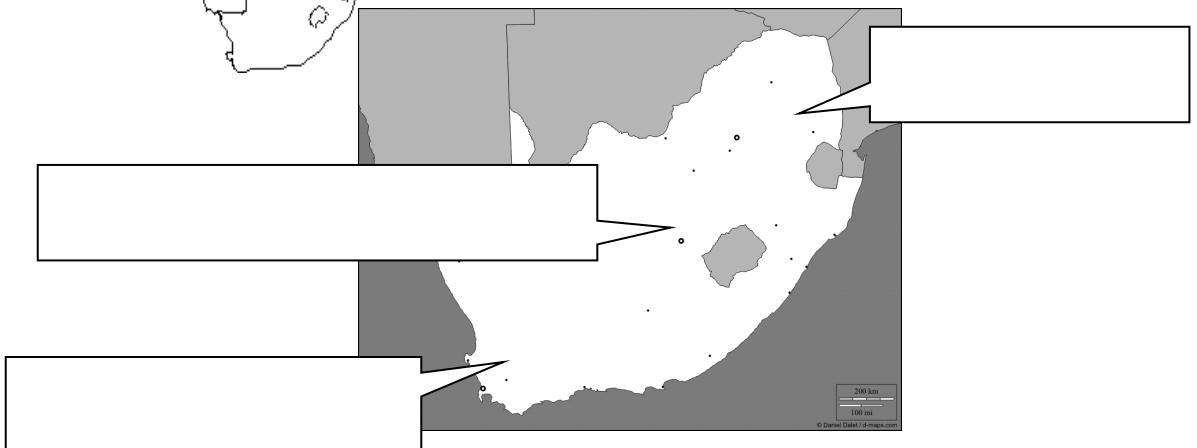

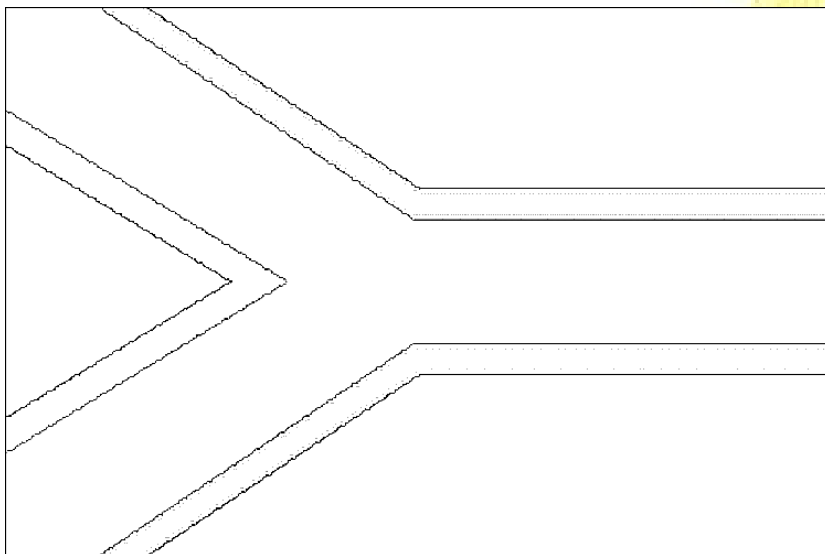

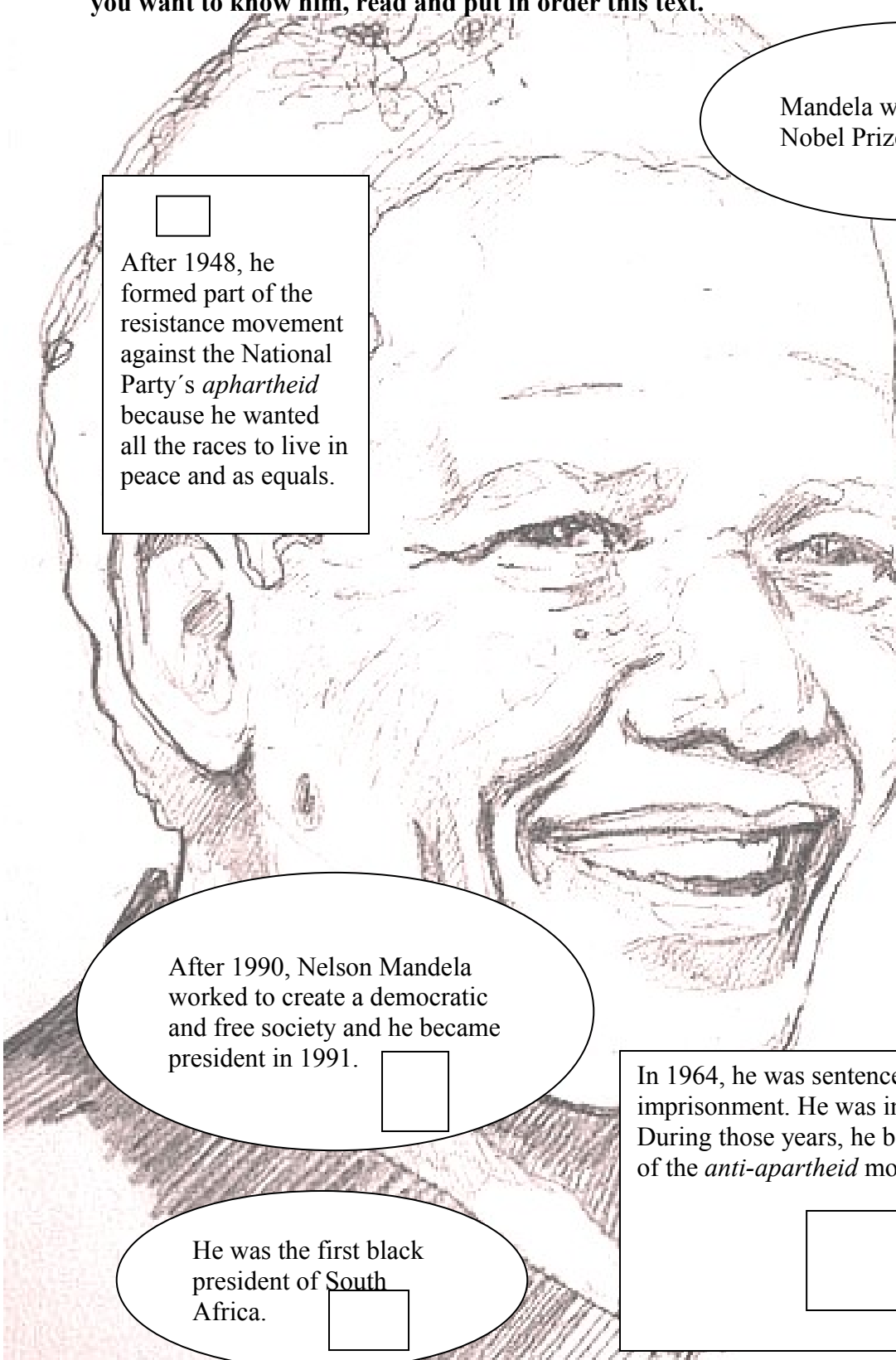

where he obtained  
his degree in law  
in 1942.

After 1990, Nelson Mandela  
worked to create a democratic  
and free society and he became  
president in 1991. ☐

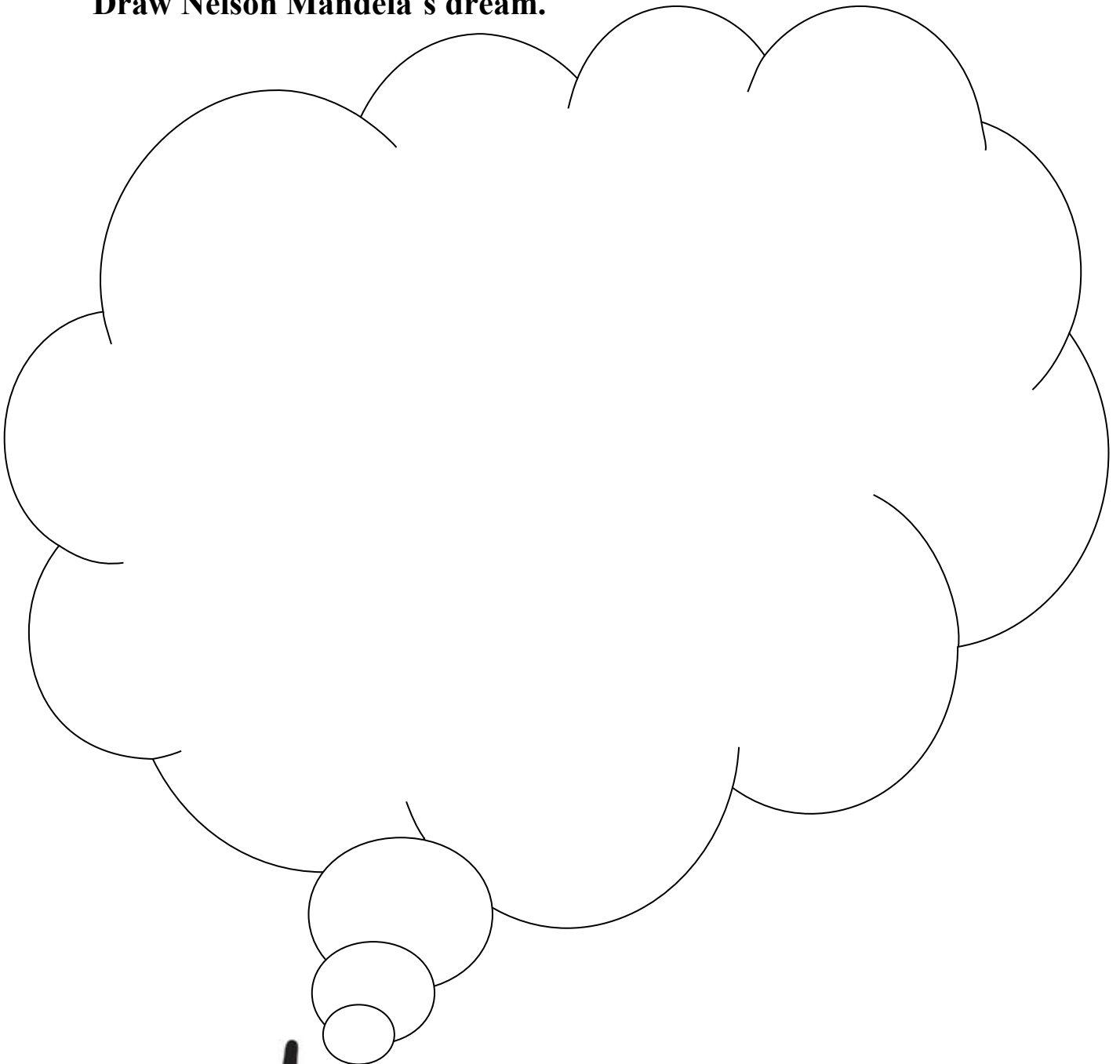
In 1964, he was sentenced to life  
imprisonment. He was in prison till 1990.

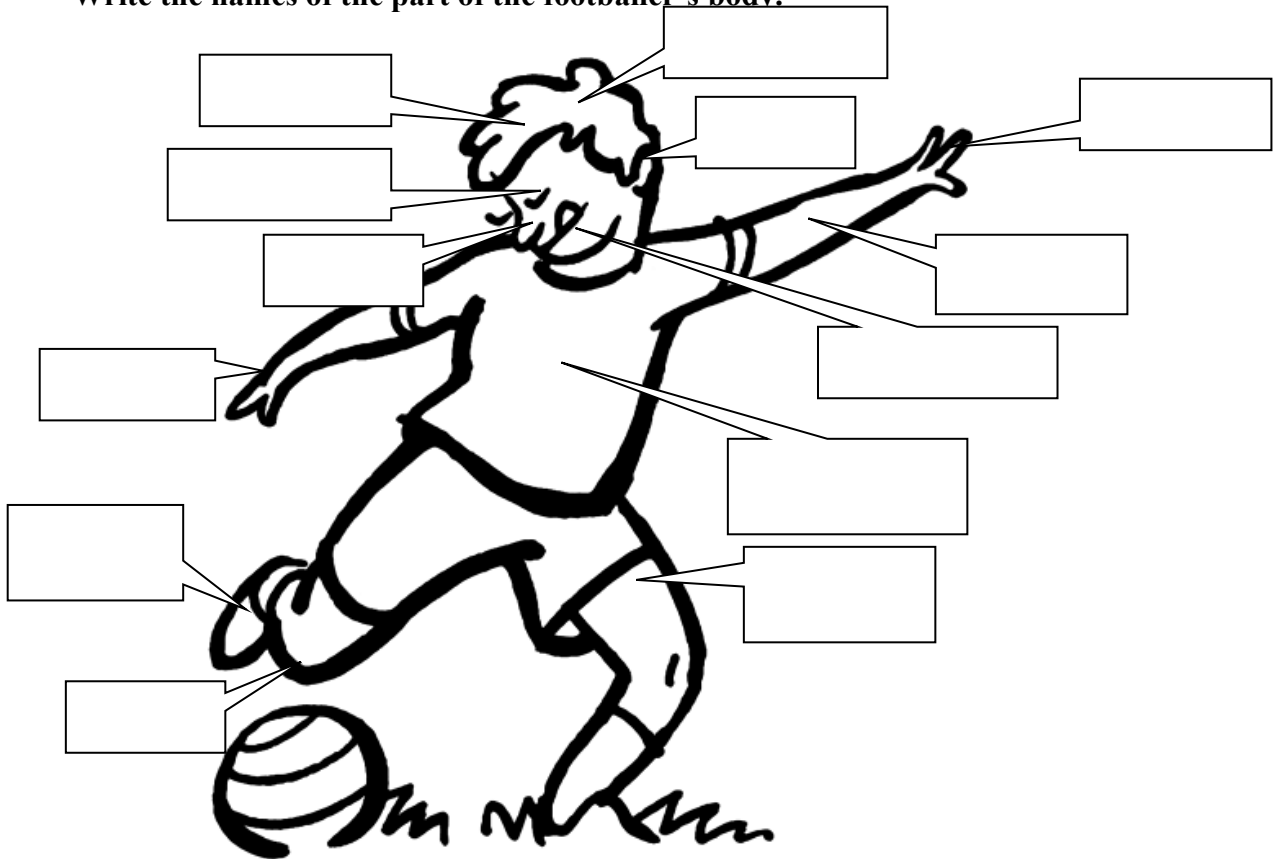
